1. Introduction

A ride on a Soaringsport.com Champaign hot air balloon ride feels vaguely like flying in a helicopter or a small plane. The difference is that powered aircraft fly where they desire. A hot air balloon goes where the wind takes it. Flying in a balloon provides total relaxation and at the same time constant excitement. The combination cannot be matched by any other experience.

Your adventure begins by watching the inflation of the balloon. The balloon, which is known in the industry as the envelope, is carefully laid on the ground. The ropes which connect the basket are laid in straight line. First fans start the inflation. Then it is finished by the burner, which is mounted on the basket and is the heat source of a hot air balloon. The balloon is then standing upright and is ready to board. First the pilot and the passengers climb in the basket. Then the pilot and the ground crew make final safety checks. Then with a roar of the burner, the balloon begins to rise.

First time balloon passengers will experience a sensation unlike any other as the term "floating on air" takes on a whole different meaning. The sensation is very calming and comfortable but at the same time looking down at the earth is engrossing. Make sure you are ready to take photos and videos of your balloon flight. Taking a pair of binoculars is also apropos.

Soaringsports.com Champaign first concern is safety. Seats are padded in the back and on the sides and there are safety belts for use in some landings. Our second concern is the passengers amazing encounter of flying in a balloon.

2. City Specific Information

Champaign is a city in Illinois about 135 miles south of Chicago and 124 miles west of Indianapolis, Indiana. There are approximately 84,000 inhabitants, making it the tenth most populous city in Illinois and the fourth most populous city outside the Chicago Metropolitan Area.

The campus of Illinois University Urbana-Champaign, with 44,000 students, is shared by Champaign and Urbana. Parkland College which has 18,000 students is located in Champaign. Due to the student populations and the numerous technology companies the area is often known as the Silicone Prairie. Champaign is home to major offices of Abbott, Archer Daniels Midland, Caterpillar, Deere & Company, Dow Chemical, IBM, State Farm Insurance and Intel, all of which are Fortune 500 companies.

Champaign was established in 1855 and was initially known as West Urbana. Champaign became an independent city when it acquired a city charter in 1860. In 1969, Carl Perkins and Bob Dylan wrote a song entitled "Champaign, Illinois" which was released on Perkins album On Top. The band "Old 97's" took another tune written by Dylan and wrote new lyrics to create another song named "Champaign, Illinois" which was released (with Dylan's blessing) on their album, *The Grand Theatre Volume One* in 2010. The songs are not similar except that Bob Dylan contributed to both of them.

In 1985 Champaign hosted the first <u>Farm Aid</u> concert which attracted 80,000 audience members and raised \$7 million for American family farmers.

In 2005, The University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign established the National Science Olympiad Tournament which attracts young scientists from around the country. And in 2013, Champaign was rated the fifth best place to live for a healthy work/life balance in the United States.

Much of the State of Illinois outside of Chicago was mostly flat prairie land before the middle of the Nineteenth Century. Champaign is located on relatively high ground with access to the Kaskaaskia River to the east and the Embarras River to the south.

Champaign has a humid continental climate. Temperatures exceed 90 degrees an average of 24 days a year and typically fall to below 0 degrees, six nights annually.

Part 2: Shared Balloon Rides

Shared Balloon Rides are the Greatest!

Have you ever seen a balloon float past and imagined that you were onboard? There are eight passenger seats in the typical hot air balloon basket. Soaringsports.com Champaign can make your dream come true. Shared ride tickets are priced for parties less than eight.

Only similar to flying in a small airplane or a helicopter in that balloons rise above the ground too. There is nothing else quite like flying in a hot air balloon. Powered aircraft flies where it wants. A balloon flies where the wind blows it.

Part of the experience is to see the balloon, or envelope in balloon terminology, inflated. The envelope is laid carefully on the ground with the lines that attach the basket to the balloon in straight lines. Large fans initially start the inflation.

On the basket is mounted the "burner", which provides the hot air. The inflation of the envelope is completed by the burner until the balloon is standing upright. The pilot enters the basket, then with the ground crew begins the safety checks. Passengers for this trip are loaded and final safety checks are completed.

With a roar of the burner and a wink of the pilot's eye, the balloon lifts off the ground. And as the ground gets progressively smaller, the term "blowin' in the wind" might come to mind. Photos and videos are a must, Binoculars are optional but fun.

Enjoy the free feeling of floating in the wind with the cities and the countryside of Central Indiana passing below. Each passenger has a seat that is padded both in the back and also on the sides.

Soaringsports.com Champaign offers hot air balloon rides year round (weather permitting). Of course, April through October are the busiest months. But be aware that hot air balloons work easier in the colder months, so if you can bundle-up and enjoy being out of doors, we can take you on a ride anytime you want.

Like all of the best experiences in life, a hot air balloon ride does come to an end. The first criteria a pilot looks for is an area with no power lines. The overwhelming majority of fatal, and even injury causing hot air balloon accidents are caused when balloons interfere with power lines.

To land, the pilot decreases the amount of heat while opening a small flap at the top of the balloon. Gradually the balloon descends. The pilot tries to adjust the decline aiming at an area large enough to land the balloon.

Under the best of conditions, the pilot sets the balloon down slowly to the ground. Other times the chase crew anticipates where the balloon will land and the crew grabs a rope, pulling the balloon down. After the balloon is dismantled and loaded on the chase vehicle, pilots and passengers ride back to the departure site.

The last nicety is at the launch site, pilots and passengers share a champagne (or carbonated fruit juice) toast to the fun everyone experienced.

All hot air balloon rides start the same. The balloon, called the envelope in the industry, is laid on the ground. The ropes attaching the basket to the balloon are laid in straight lines. The inflation begins with large fans and are finished by the "burner" in the basket. The burner is what makes the air hot in a hot air balloon.

When the balloon stands upright, the pilot enters the basket. The pilot and the ground crew make preliminary safety checks and the passengers are encouraged to board. After everyone is in the basket, the ground crew makes final safety checks,

With a roar from the burner, the balloon lifts into the air. Initially, first time passengers have never experienced such a thing. Balloons are similar to small airplanes and helicopters only because the all three rise into the air. But powered aircraft go where they intend to go. Hot air balloons go where the wind takes them.

All balloon rides include a toast at the end of the ride (champagne or carbonated fruit juice). But that toast can be shared during the flight, if preferred.

The balloon ride usually lasts about an hour but plan to be involved for 2-1/2 -3 hours including the inflation and a ride back to the launch site.

Balloons are landed by reducing the heat and opening a small flap near the top of the balloon. Ground crews can also grab a rope and pull the basket down.

Not all hot air balloon ride operators reserve private balloons but we at Soaringsports.com Champaign can help plan just the right atmosphere to be deployed to make your private balloon ride supremely remembered.

Part 4: Tethered Balloon Rides

Title: Tethered Balloon Rides are Perfect for Large Events

Body:

A tethered hot air balloon ride is perfect for a fair, a carnival, a grand opening or a sales promotion. A private balloon ride would be the center of attention not only at any private party but in the entire neighborhood surrounding the party.

A tethered balloon goes up to between 25 and 100 feet high, depending on the terrain, the wind and the anchor points, A sign can also be placed on the balloon and a balloon can be noticed surprisingly well.

Typically rides last about 5 minutes in the air. People can certainly see the world from a different perspective, floating in a balloon, even if it is for a short time. Anyone who is capable of stepping into the basket is able to enjoy the ride. And just the excitement of possibly flying in a balloon attracts crowds.

Baskets have eight passenger seats but depending on the weight of the passengers, a tethered balloon ride can lift 45-50 people per hour. The balloon ride usually lasts about two hours. Precise flying time is dependent on the wind, the rise height, the weight of individual passengers and ultimately the legal amount of fuel permitted on board a balloon.

Tethered balloons can only be flown when the wind is under 5 mph. In stronger winds, the balloon might be difficult to control and therefore dangerous. It is the pilot who ultimately decides when it is safe to fly a balloon.

Tethered balloon rides from Soaringsports.com Champaign can fly year round (weather permitting). The most popular flying times are during sunrise and sunset and wind is weakest at those hours too. But balloons can be flown at any hour of the day and into the night. Think big - illuminate a balloon after dark and it can be seen from far away.

Tethered balloons require an area 250 feet by 250 feet which is clear of trees, electric poles or even just electric wires, any bushes or any kind of debris. Four anchor points are necessary like a big tree trunk, well imbedded fencing posts or a heavy vehicle. We bring a big truck to every balloon event but we still need the other three anchor points.
